


STEWARDSHIP IN ACTION

During the week of June 6-18, a special group of children and adult leaders participated in Helping Hands Camp. The campers learned about the importance of helping others and then went to work! They accomplished the following in just one week:

- Packed 200 lunches for MUST Ministries Summer Lunch Program
- Packed 100 Blessing Bags for CFUMC Summer Lunch Program
- Packed 950 Backpacks of school supplies for Forsyth County Schools
- Packed 750 pounds of food for the Food Pantry Hispanic outreach
- Played Bingo with and brought gift bags for the residents of Chestnut Ridge Retirement Home
- Planted a Memorial garden and cleaned up trash at Walker Therapy Horse Farm

Also, during the week, the Forsyth County Public Library Outreach Director came and taught the campers about the public library, its resources, and how you can volunteer in the community through the library. Then, representatives from the Youth Ecuador Mission trip came and talked about global missions. Finally, while the campers were volunteering at the Horse Farm, they were taught all about how horses are used for therapy for special needs children.
