Cumming First United Methodist Church is more than a place of worship; we are a dynamic community dedicated to embodying Christ's love in all we do. Your financial giving plays a crucial role in sustaining ministries that feed the hungry, nurture children in faith, and offers healing to countless individuals within our community and beyond.
