Guide to Making Your Estimate of Generosity for April 1 – December 31, 2024

As you walk the pathway of generosity, you may have questions about how much to give. Here's a practical suggestion for how you might approach this decision:

- 1. Pray with God and ask God to guide you as you make this decision.
- 2. Start by identifying a specific percentage of your income. Write down the number and pray over it. Ask God to help you see how this gift would help you to grow in faith and make a difference for God's kingdom. As you pray, God may confirm or challenge your decision!
- 3. Look over your budget with your number in mind. Remember that when God is guiding your decision making, God may challenge you to reevaluate some of your other financial commitments and priorities. Your decision here may cause the need to order and discipline other areas of your life something we all could use.
- 4. Once you have arrived at the level you feel is the right spiritual step, fill out your *Estimate of Generosity* card and **submit it by March 17** at worship in person or online at cfumcga.com/generosity.
- 5. After making your estimate set aside your gift as the "first fruits" of your income as a way of honoring God as the source of all that you have. That way you're giving to God from the first and best of your resources rather than from what is leftover.

Remember, the journey of generosity is an intimate part of your spiritual journey, so there's no one-size-fits-all "right" amount to give. What matters most is the sincerity of your heart in aligning your giving with God's vision.
